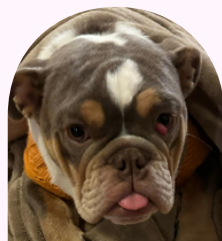

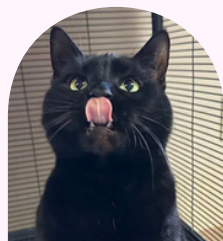

BONDED BOTTLE BABIES FIND FOREVER HOMES



Adopting a bonded pair of cats not only enriches your life but also improves theirs. Studies have shown that bonded pairs experience lower levels of stress and anxiety when kept together, leading to healthier and happier lives. Adopting a duo means saving two lives instead of one, doubling the impact of your decision. With companionship built-in, bonded pairs often adjust more quickly to their new environment, reducing behavioral issues commonly seen in single animals. This effect is only multiplied with young kittens who require extra playtime attention.
